In 1756, the British began to defeat the French, especially in naval battles. In 1759, General James Wolfe's army defeated the French at Quebec (although both Gen. Wolfe and his French adversary Gen. Montcalm both ______ during the battle).

The French lost the war, and the Treaty of Paris (signed in _____) gave Britain control of Canada. Spain gave Florida to Britain, and received the former French areas west of the Mississippi River.
